Re: LGVSD Sphere of Influence

The February 2006 LAFCO staff report, Page 146 "Recommended Sphere of Influence" last sentence, suggests a removal of the designated open space area in the San Rafael Ridge/Sleepy Hollow-Terra Linda Divide area from the District SOI.

LGVSD will, in the immediate future, provide recycled treated wastewater to specific areas of our District and areas to the north of our District. Should the District be asked to provide recycled treated wastewater to the aforementioned open space for irrigation or fire protection, we would want the area to be part of our designated service area.

Therefore, we request that the LAFCO Commission not change our Sphere of Influence in the manner suggested in the staff report. Representatives of the District will attend your April 13, 2006 Hearing to address the concerns of the District.
